Our Public Forum coincides with the Severn Tidal Power Consultation currently being undertaken by the Department of Energy and Climate Change http://severntidalpowerconsultation.decc.gov.uk/feasibility_study_overview.

We aim to provide a neutral space for members of the public to consider the evidence and to develop their own informed opinions on the strengths and weaknesses of various options which DECC are examining to exploit the tidal energy of the Severn Estuary. Outcomes will be fed into the Government Feasibility Study and will be more widely disseminated.

The programme will include a brief overview of the Government's Severn tidal power study by Claire Gibson, Director of Sustainable Resources, South West of England Regional Development Agency, and four short presentations of key information given by specialists on the Engineering Options, Habitat-Ecology consequences, the Socio-Economic dimension and Sustainability issues. Speakers include Prof Colin Taylor, Bristol University Dept of Civil Engineering and Peter Jones RSPB Cymru. The remaining time will involve structured discussion in small groups in which your participation will be very important.
