This exciting afternoon will begin by looking at artistic interventions as being carried out at HMP Parc, followed by an overview of the ethos and practice at the Ruskin Mill Educational Trust and finally a presentation will be given on possible new developments at the Earth For Life Land Trust.

PHIL FORDER FRSA is currently Arts Interventions Manager at HMP/YOI Parc in Bridgend South Wales. His work has included the creation of The Art Of Living programme, a motivational course for adults that uses art as its medium. Hay-in-the-Parc, A literary festival for prisoners sponsored by the Hay Festival. Parcomix, a printing imprint that uses comics to disseminate information, and Lounge Learning, a means to educate through the use of film. He is also the author of 'Bang-Up for Men-The Smell of Prison' under the pen name of Adrian Rudesind

AONGHUS GORDON FRSA is from a background in arts and education, Aonghus founded the Living Earth Training Course in 1984, which developed into Ruskin Mill Educational Trust in 1996. He went on to establish the Glasshouse College, Stourbridge, in 2000 and Freeman College, Sheffield in 2005. He co-founded the Makhad Trust for endangered nomadic tribes particularly in Sinai in 2003, co-founded The Hiram Trust in 1994 and co-founded The Waldorf College, Stroud, Gloucestershire in 1999. Awarded Social Entrepreneur of the Year for the South of England in 2005. He established Clervaux College in Darlington in 2008 for young people who are not in education employment or training in conjunction with Darlington Council.
